OVERVIEW

The USAID Privacy Office, in conjunction the Bureau for Management, conducted a PIA of the AIDNet GSS. The AIDNET GSS is the interconnected set of information resources under the common management control of, and which provide the common functionality as the local area network (LAN) for USAID.

INFORMATION COLLECTION (WHAT)

The AIDNet is the general support system (GSS) for the Agency. The GSS does not directly collect, maintain or disseminate personally identifiable information (PII). It is the backbone of the agency's information systems consisting of servers, routers, firewalls, and other infrastructure components. This integrated set of hardware and software components provides the technological platform on which other agency systems reside, interconnect the USAID Missions, authenticate the employee and contractor personnel, provide a suite of common desktop applications for their use, and provides network file storage and printing services.
